1.	Powder-liquid preparation:
	A. Levigate the Progesterone (Micronized) with the Ethoxy Diglycol.
	End result: Homogeneous paste-like dispersion.
2.	Powder-liquid to medium integration:
	A. Incrementally add the homogeneous paste-like dispersion (Step 1A) to the VersaPro TM Lotion Base (60.0 mL <i>plus</i> processing error adjustments).
	Specifications: Continuously mix, using high-shear mixing techniques.
	End result: Homogeneous lotion-like dispersion.
3.	Filling to volume:
	A. Add additional VersaPro TM Lotion Base to the mixture (Step 2A) to fill to the required batch size (100.0 mL <i>plus</i> processing error adjustments).
	Specifications: Continuously mix, using high-shear mixing techniques.
	End result: Homogeneous lotion-like dispersion.
4.	Product transfer:
	A. Transfer the final product into the specified dispensing container (see "Packaging requirements").
