	Preparatory Instruction
1.	Medium preparation:
	A. In the given order, sequentially add the following ingredients to the Isopropyl Alcohol (Alcohol 99%):
	-Glycerin -Hydrogen Peroxide Concentrate (30% w/w)
	Specifications: Continuously mix.
	End result: Homogeneous liquid-like solution.
	Note: Add the next ingredient, once the previous one has been completely added and dissolved.
2.	Filling to Volume:
	A. Add Purified Water to the homogeneous liquid-like solution (Step 1A) to fill to the required batch size (100.0 mL <i>plus</i> processing error adjustments).
	Specifications: Continuously mix.
	End result: Homogeneous liquid-like solution.
3.	Product transfer:
	Transfer the final product into the specified dispensing container (see "Packaging Requirements").
